

**The project «E-CULTS – European Citizens for Culture and Solidarity»

Participation: The project involved 310 citizens, notably 110 participants from the city of Swieqi (Malta), 35 participants from the city of Deryneia (Cyprus), 30 participants from the city of Jevisovice (Czech Republic), 35 participants from the city of Arnot (Hungary), 35 participants from the city of Soriano nel Cimino (Italy), 30 participants from the city of Costanta (Romania), 35 participants from the Municipality of Gradoli (Italy).

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Swieqi (Swieqi, Malta), from 11/04/2019 to 18/04/2019

Short description:

The day of 11/04/2019 was dedicated to: Arrivals of the international delegations, orientative meeting, presentation of the Activity Plan, welcome speech by the Mayor of Swieqi Mr. Noel Muscat.

The day of 14/04/2019 was dedicated to: report by each delegation of the local survey sent to the target 15-25 years old, group work on youth engagement, report of the group work, visit and exchange of practices in the Millennium Chapel in Saint Julian, meeting with the Mayor of Saint Julian Mr. Guido Dalli, Signature of the Friendship and cooperation agreement.

The day of 15/04/2019 was dedicated to: group work and analysis of wrong practices in youth involvement, effects of international crisis on youth participation, the solidal and social role of youth, Problem Family Tree activity, report of the group work, integrational activities.

The day of 16/04/2019 was dedicated to: gender balance and role of women in times of crisis, best practices in young women engagement, unconference on project's results, cultural visit, free time with local citizens, participation in activities for the preparation of the Easter celebration.
